

2nd INTERNATIONAL and 3rd NATIONAL CONGRESS of POSTPARTUM CARE

FULL TEXT Article Writing Instructions

Below mentioned formal rules should be followed if the abstract is accepted for full text.

Research Articles; Should include Abstract (written in Turkish and English), Introduction, Aim & Objectives, Methods, Findings, Discussion, Utilization of Results in the Field of Application, References.

Review Articles: should include Abstract (written in Turkish and English), Introduction, Body, Conclusion and References.

In the Introduction paragraph, the scope of the review should be framed. The importance of the scope and the objectives of the view should be thoroughly explained. In the Body paragraph, a form related to the scope of the view should be structured.

Case presentations should include Abstract (Turkish and English), Introduction, Case presentation, Discussion, References. Photographs and flow charts can be benefited to support the structure of case presentations. Photographs and flow charts require permission.

Page Structure and Form: All of the articles should not exceed 15 pages. Abstracts and references are included in 15 page limitation. Articles should be written in Microsoft Word, size of an A4 page. 2.5 cm from the left and right edges of the page should be left and spacing between lines should be 1.5 cm. Times New Roman should be used as the font for the entire article. Font size should be 12. Articles should be submitted electronically from the web page of the Congress.

The initials of the main heading (Introduction, Methods, Findings etc.) should be written in capitals, bold and centered. The initials of the subheadings should be written in capitals, italics, bold and aligned to the left.

Abstracts: The abstract should be limited to the same word count (maximum of 350 words) and content as it's accepted by the Congress Abstract System. It should be written in both Turkish and English. Turkish and English abstracts should be located at separate pages and written in the font size of 12. The reference section cannot be included to the abstract.

Research Articles;

Introduction part should include the approaches in the related literature and the aim of the study. This part should also include the objectives or research question / hypothesis.

Methods; Subheadings should include type of research, the environment where the research is conducted, sample of the research, data collection tools, interventions (it is required if there search is experimental or quasi-experimental)

, evaluation of data and ethics of the research (research ethics committee approval/ institution approval, written/verbal informed consent)
Findings; descriptive statistics of the collected data (number, percentage, mean, standard deviation etc), statistical tests, test and probability (p) values should be stated precisely.

Tables and Figures: Number and the title of the table should be written on the top of the table, initials should be written in capitals, bold and font size should be 12. Tables should not include vertical lines. Each table should have a reference in the text. Inside the table, spacing between lines should be 1 and the font size should be 10. Descriptions regarding the table should be written by using marks such as "*", "**", "***", with a spacing of 1 and a font size of 10.

Figures/charts and images: Figures should be numbered and titled, titles should be located under the figures/charts. The name of the figures/charts and images should be aligned to the left, font size of 12, the initials of the words should be written in capitals and bold.

If the figures/charts and images are from another source, there should be a footnote which states the references. Figures/charts and images should be placed appropriately in the text. The number of figures/charts and images should not exceed 6 in total.

Discussion: Findings of the research should be interpreted and discussed in the light of the literature and other related study results.

Utilization of Results in the Field of Application; The contribution of the results in terms of their utilization in the field of applications should be stated and suggestions regarding collected findings of that study should be made.

References;

All citations used in the text should be included in the Reference section and all of the references should be present in the text. APA 6 Style is a requirement.
